Roof Replacement Project: Permission granted to enter into an agreement through the Tremco/Waterproofing Technologies contract of the Omnia Partners Public Sector Cooperative using the in-network contractor of David M. Maines Associates, Inc. for roof replacement for designated sections of the second floor roof pending final approval from solicitor. This project is to be funded through funds retained in the Capital Projects fund (namely from the sale of the Rail Training Center) and the funds retained in the General Fund for possible acquisition of the Belmar property.
