Proposed tuition rates for Postsecondary diploma programs for 2022-2023:

This represents an approximate increase of 3% for all programs except for Welding, Practical Nursing, and EFDA. The Continuing Education Department is in the process of reviewing all textbooks, supply costs, and fees in order to further contain the cost of postsecondary education.

Notes:

\*The tuition for the welding program is dependent upon approval of the revised program hours by the Middle States Association Commissions on Elementary and Secondary Schools. The JOC previously approved the reduction of program hours from 900 to 800 hours. If reduction in hours is not approved, the rate will be \$10,148.

\*\* Practical Nursing tuition represents 5% increase to prior year full-time tuition rate as we anticipate additional staffing costs and costs due to proposed changes by the State Board of Nursing may require us to acquire regional program accreditation for the Practical Nursing program.

No changes to the EFDA tuition. We anticipate a program revision for 2023-2024.

<u>Postsecondary Program Name Revision</u>: Approved diploma program name changed from Medical Office Specialist to Medical Administrative Assistant to better reflect the careers in the healthcare industry.

<u>Articulation Agreements</u>: Permission granted to execute two Statewide articulation agreements (SOAR) providing credit from the health occupations secondary program (CIP Code 51.0899) into the Medical Assistant and Medical Administrative Assistant postsecondary programs. Up to 9 credits may be provided for students who are completers of the 51.0899 secondary program who enroll into the Medical Assistant and Medical Administrative Assistant diploma programs.
