Agreements were revised per direction from PDE from original request in March 2022.
- b. Granted retroactive permission to execute an articulation agreement with Pittsburgh Technical College for Digital Communications, Computer Programming/Oracle Academy, Computer & Networking Technology, Baking and Pastry Arts, Culinary Arts or Food Services, Electro Mechanical Engineering Technology, Drafting/Design Technology, Emergency Services, Electrical Trades, HVAC/Plumbing, Welding Technology, and Graphic Design.
