Criteria:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Blair County High School who has lost an immediate family member, relative, or close friend to a violent crime (homicide, homicide by vehicle, homicide by vehicle DUI, arson, murder, etc.). To be considered in this category, in most cases, charges have been filed by the police. Missing persons and suspicious deaths will also be considered. Suicides do not meet the eligibility requirements.
- Must be attending a post-secondary educational institution
